## Open Morning

It is a great event for the children to attend and all children in year 3-6 are encouraged to take part. The event starts at 12.45 (to walk the course) so we will need to leave here asap after 12pm with the children having an early packed lunch. St Petrocs are not charging to take part but will be selling light refreshments/snacks in the pavilion after the event, the children will each be given a voucher for a free hot chocolate but parents may like to send along a small amount of money for them to purchase something. We have booked a minibus to help with transport but will need several parent volunteers as well please – it is always an enjoyable event in a beautiful location – do join us if you can. ## Music - reminder

Our new music tutor, Tony Jones, will be offering a couple of clubs as well as private lessons (trumpet, cornet, baritone), vocal coaching and music theory, these will be lunchtime and after school on Thursdays. The cost will be £10 per a 20-minute lesson, or for any children that are already competent, a one-hour lesson for £20. Tony can do a one-hour group lesson for up to 5 children if there is sufficient interest (with the charge shared accordingly). Tony hopes to make instruments available through his Holsworthy Town Band connection. Music clubs will be choir on Wednesday lunchtimes and Pocket Trumpet Club which will be for 1 hour after school on Wednesdays (there will be a £2 charge to help towards costs). We have a class set of instruments on hire and children will be able to borrow those – parents will be required to sign to take responsibility for any instrument being borrowed through the school. If anyone else is interested in the pocket trumpet club or music lessons, please let us know asap so these can be booked in – see response slip from previous newsletter - thank you.
