Academic - Tribal Tales.

- In Literacy we will be exploring poetry to start looking at our dreams and aspirations. Through our poetry unit we will look at sentence structure and the different language that we can use to engage the reader. We are then moving on to a narrative piece of English work and looking at recounts of events. Each of these topics will link with our virtues.
- In Maths we will start with place value and then moving on to the four operations, which are addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- In Science, we will be learning about Sound and Light.
- In History we will look at the Stone Age and how Britain has changed from the Stone Age to today.
- In Geography we will be exploring Maps and looking at physical features.
- In PE we will develop our stamina and determination by learning a range of new skills as we learn to play team games and use a range of equipment safely.
- In creative sessions we will explore music/arts inspired by a range of cultures. We will use a range of different techniques and materials to create art to represent core virtues.
- In MFL we will be focusing on French this term, we will be talking about describing ourselves as a person.
- In RE we will be exploring the question, 'Why do some people follow God?'

Innovation

This term Fox Class will have opportunities to deepen their understanding of a range of cultures around the world and celebrate the similarities and differences that we encounter along the way.

- Make stronger links with our friends at EduKid and learn more about our sponsored child; Nick.
- Continue to work with EduKids Global Citizenship Programme
- Explore what friendship and generosity are as core virtues and have the opportunity to look at our own actions and think about innovative ways that we can bring about positive changes.
- Through our topic sessions we will discover changes around the world and how life has change and developed over thousands of years.
