

## Academic

- **Personal, Social and Emotional Development:** Children will be encouraged to work as part of a group to plan how to achieve an outcome. They will talk about their ideas and evaluate the end product, identifying aspects they might change.
- **Communication and Language:** The children will be introduced to a range of technical vocabulary and will be encouraged to use new words to add information, express ideas and to explain events.
- **Physical Development:** We will explore why exercise is important for good health and work on our co-ordination, balance and agility.
- **Literacy:** We will work on our composition skills and practice putting our thoughts into full sentences, using capital letters and full stops. We will send letters and invitations, make non-fiction books and write stories through innovating key texts.
- **Maths:** We will be counting and ordering numbers to 20, adding and subtracting, doubling and halving as well as exploring odd and even numbers.
- **Knowledge and Understanding of the World:** We will make observations of plants and animals and talk about what they need to grow and change. We will also explore ways in which we can help to maintain the area in which we live.
- **Expressive Arts and Design:** We will explore different media and techniques to create our own artwork, including our own versions of 'The Snail' by Henri Matisse and hats to wear at our Jubilee celebrations. We will also sing songs, create dances and compose music related to our topics.

## Innovation

This term Hedgehog Class will have opportunities to serve our school and local community. We will plan, create and develop ideas through:

- Growing food in the garden to use in cooking.
- Designing a flower garden to attract insects such as bees and butterflies.
- Building a bug hotel to provide a safe habitat for our insects.
- Visiting a local beach and exploring ways in which we can help keep the habitat safe for animals that live there.
- Planning a Jubilee party, including invitations, food and songs!
- Designing hats to wear at the Queen's Jubilee celebrations!
