Academic:

This half term we are starting to learn about the Mayan society. We will find out where the Maya lived and the significant events which occurred in their time. We will look at the Maya city states and what happened to these. We will also learn about the Maya inventions and see how many of these are still in use today. Finally we will compare this ancient civilisation with the Anglo Saxons in Britain.



In science we are going to learn about Space. We will learn about the solar system, the planets, modelling and the motion of the Earth. We will also look at space travel.

We will start the terms literacy with extended third party narratives focusing on adventure stories. We will develop the settings and the character using noun phrases, similes, personification and different sentence structures to create suspense. We will then move on to our second unit of Explanatory texts.

Maths will consist of ratio, algebra and decimals for year 6 with multiplication and division, fractions and decimals for year 5. We will also continue with our daily tough ten questions.
