In Geography we will be looking at environmental regions, looking at how and why these change across the world in different continents and countries.

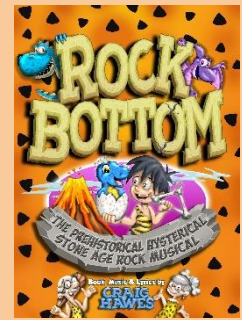
In Science we will be looking at different states of matter. We will be exploring solids, liquids and gases and how different materials change states.
