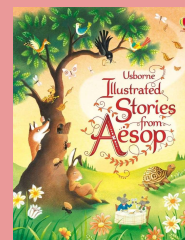


## Hedgehogs and Squirrels - Autumn Term 2

#### Academic:

- As masters of maths we will explore addition and subtraction, place value and shape.

- As artists we will create maps of our local area through various art forms, including drawing, felt making, printmaking and designing stained glass.



#### Character:

Our focus virtues are **compassion, courage, determination, service and generosity**. We will:

- Explore these virtues in our whole school and class based assemblies.
- Share stories with these virtues as the main theme.
- Celebrate any virtues we see 'in action' by placing a leaf on our character tree and sharing certificates in celebration assemblies.
- Participate in enrichment activities to help us gain our Inspiring Changemaker Award. We will be Inspiring Adventurers by visiting Beer Mill, Inspiring Researchers by learning about the physical and human features of our local area and Inspiring Skill Builders by developing our drawing, printing and designing skills. We will also be Inspiring Fundraisers by planning an event to raise money to purchase some new playground equipment.



#### Community:

Children will:

- Explore ways in which their playground can be improved.
- Learn about land use around the local area.
- Visit Beer Mill and learn about the trees, plants and animals that can be found near our school.
- Explore and create maps of our school and the local area.
- Take part in Christmas celebrations with the community.



#### Digital and Innovation:

- Use drawing, felt making and printing techniques to create a map of the local area
- Use the Chromebooks to create a presentation about our school and the local area for visitors.
