Topic: How Do I Get Around

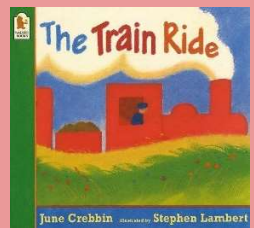
Theme: Transportation

This term Owls will be focusing on Transport and how to get around. Under this topic they will be:

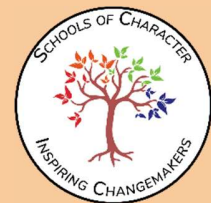
- Learning all about the history and investigating different types of transport.
