



# **Owls - Spring 2**

#### **Academic:**

This half term Owls will be focusing on where have we been on holiday? We plan on looking at popular types of holidays and destinations: exploring beach holidays; learning about where Spain and France are; camping and caravan holidays in Devon and Cornwall; and, learning about London.

Alongside this, Owls will be exploring some memorable dates, such as Shrove Tuesday, World book Day, Mother's Day and Easter.

In our Maths journey, we will be moving on to the number 3 and the triangle shape. Learning our Numbers 1-5 is a very important milestone in Owls, so to make Maths fun and interesting is our goal!

Our new Talk for Writing story will be one of our favourites - A hole in the bottom of the sea written by Jessica Law. We will be learning lots of different Makaton signs along with the fantastic song! We will aim to perform it too for you, working towards our inspiring storytelling certificate!

In our understanding the world focus, we will be looking at flags (Devon, Cornwall, Spain and France) also creating our own flags.

#### **Character:**

Our character virtues for this half term are: Resilience, Motivation, Justice, Forgiveness, Patience.

We will be working towards becoming an inspiring skill builder and storytellers (speakers). We will be focusing on our British Value of Democracy (voting activities, turn taking games, sharing and listening to each other)
