

Fox Class - Where does our food come from?

Academic:

As we approach the final half term of the year, we will be very busy!

Our final geography topic of the year is looking at where our food comes from. In this unit we will be identifying that foods grow in different biomes. We will be exploring which food has the most significant negative impact on the environment and how this is reduced. We will look at Fair Trade and the journey of a cocoa bean!

As geographers, we will be locating different countries using an atlas and google earth and google maps. In maths we will be finishing fractions then moving on to decimals, time and money. In English we will be continuing to embed adjectives, expanded noun phrases and adverbs whilst also introducing similes and metaphors in all our final writing pieces. In Science our unit links to geography - looking at muscles and the nutritional value of foods that we eat and how this impacts our bodies. This half term we will be looking at an art focus unit on Power Prints and different techniques to printing.



Character:

This half term our focus virtues are citizenship, caring, volunteering, gratitude and reflection to end the year. There will be many more virtues needed especially as we begin to practice our end of year production. This will require all virtues to be demonstrated and for some children this will be a huge step out of their usually comfortable characters.
